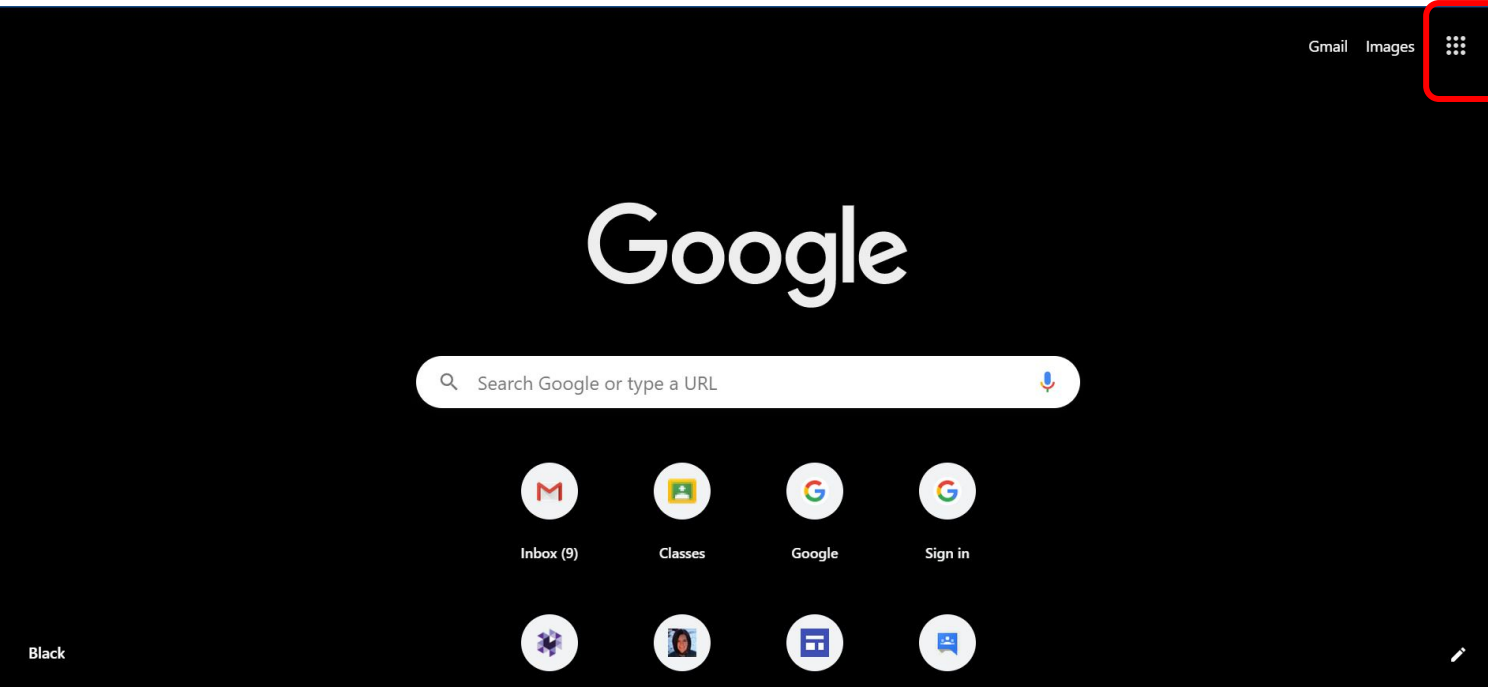
# Logging in to Chrome Account

When a virtual learner chooses to use a device that they have at home instead of the Chromebook, the student may need to access their school account in a different way.

This is a simple process and can allow the student to still have access to their Google Classrooms, Clever information, and other accounts linked to the Franklin County G-Suite for Education.



# Step 1: Get on to the Google Chrome Browser



First you will need to open a Google Chrome Web Browser

Use another account

If you have logged in before, the account will be listed already.


If this is the first time logging in, you will need to click “Use another account”
